RISE Project Extends Dialogue within Asia Through Addition of...

- The recent 3rd International Conference on Ethics and Policies of Biometrics and International Data Sharing was a resounding success. The Conference took place in China on 4-5 January 2010, and was hosted by the Biometric Research Centre of the Polytechnic University of Hong Kong, a member of the RISE Consortium.

In addition to deepening the understanding of global issues related to data protection and privacy, the RISE Consortium established a dialogue that resulted in the addition of a new consortium member: National ChengChi University of Taiwan, represented by Prof. Chi-Shing Chen from the College of Law. The RISE Consortium views the addition of the National ChengChi University of Taiwan as an extraordinary opportunity to extend the global dialogue on biometrics, data protection and ethics further within Asia. In addition, with National ChengChi University's addition, two new conference events have been added to the RISE project, which are being organized by Prof. Chen and his team. The first is a RISE conference to be held in Taipei in October 2010, and a subsequent workshop in Beijing in September 2011.

Beyond this advancement of the consortium's work, the 3rd International Conference provided a broad range of perspectives to the audience of policy makers, industrial players, and others in attendance. The next major event sponsored by the RISE consortium will be held in Brussels on March 25-26 2010. This high-level workshop will focus on 'Ethical and Policy Implications of Global Mobility and Security.' Speakers will include Mr. Siim Kallas, Vice-President of the European Commission, and Transport Commissioner; Mr. Jaak Aaviksoo, Estonian Minister of Defense and Mr. Peter Hustinx, European Data Protection Supervisor. The RISE consortium includes the project coordinator, the Centre for Science, Society and Citizenship (IT) and project partners, Aristotle University of Thessaloniki (GR), Biometric Research Centre (CHINA), Center for Policy on Emerging Technologies (US), Cesagen (UK), Global Security Intelligence (US), European Biometric Forum (IR), NASSCOM - DSCI (INDIA), the University of Tartu (EE), and the National ChengChi University of Taiwan.
